Under light to moderate supervision, this position develops new analytic and decisioning solutions and serves as a resource for many new and existing solutions supported by Analytical Services. Prepares and presents information on the business units products and services to current clients, prospective customers, and the sales force. Assignments at this level are diverse and complex within the positions subject matter expertise. At this career stage, the incumbent is developing the capacity to apply products and services from outside his/her area of expertise to provide total customer solutions.

This position specializes in applying techniques from the Information Technology field to the Analytical Development Groups objectives. Projects will involve writing complex SAS programs, in both the IBM mainframe and Windows PC environments, to summarize and analyze large quantities of data. Projects that involve summarizing data to find business implications require thorough knowledge of data mining techniques. In all cases, this position will be responsible for developing his/her own design requirements and project plans with limited supervisory assistance, in order to fulfill customers needs in a timely fashion.

#### **Duties & Responsibilities:**

1. With light to moderate supervisory assistance, develops and implements custom analytical work for TransUnion's customers. Consults with customers to identify business needs, identifies and designs analysis that meets those needs, carries out analysis, presents results and business significance of analysis to customers, and implements results at TransUnion and/or customers sites. The majority of this positions custom analytical projects will involve a high percentage of programming design and analytical programming work.
2. Attends and sometimes leads customer meetings as required, as part of the total consulting process.
3. Coordinates completion of customers analytical projects with other areas of the company, as required by our customers needs.
4. Educates sales force and other company associates about opportunities for applying areas of expertise to our customers business needs.
5. Identifies new software or other tools needed to create analytical solutions for customers, within area of expertise. Prepares justification of the related expenses for managements review and approval. Integrate use of new software or other tools into the teams work processes.
6. Performs other duties as assigned

7. Minimum 5 years SAS programming experience. Minimum of 1 year experience with the IBM mainframe computing environment, including using JCL.
8. SAS Certification required.
9. Must be able to complete project-oriented work requiring the combination of synthesizing and analyzing information, and determining the appropriate course of action based on the information.
10. Ability to work on a variety of tasks simultaneously with varying deadlines.
